

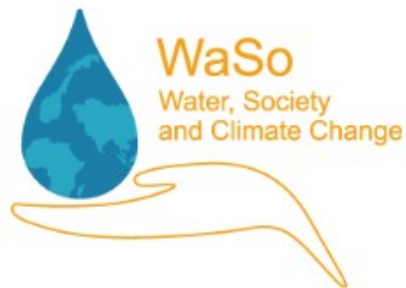

The above international conference is planned for 16th and 17th of December, 2016 with WaSo-Asia special session to be held on 17th of December from 9.00 am onwards. It will provide a special forum for researchers in the area of sustainable built environments to share their knowledge and research findings. WaSo-Asia Special session is planned as part of the sessions parallel to this international conference under WaSo-Asia Project.

Programs of WaSo-Asia Project sponsored by Norad are designed to join different disciplines from meteorology to humanities and social science to take a holistic approach to resource management, climate change adaptation and mitigation research with special reference to water and society. Institutional capacities of the participating institutions are strengthened to improve the capacity of staff to supervise master and PhD students as well as to do quality independent research. North-South and South-South technology transfer and networking are established through collaborative research, joint research supervision, staff and student exchange and dissemination of knowledge through seminars and scientific meetings organized and carried out effectively under the project.

This special session is limited for the contributions from WaSo-Asia and WaSo-Africa project partners. Authors are invited to submit abstracts written in English with about 250 words related to the Special session of the conference. Abstracts should include the full title of the paper and provide a brief and comprehensive summary of the purpose, content and conclusions of the manuscript with 3-5 key words. Author/s are required to provide their name, affiliation, address, e-mail addresses and telephone/fax.

All contributions must be of high quality, original and not published elsewhere or submitted for publication during the review process. A scientific committee consisting referees of international reputation will review all the papers. All the accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings. Papers will only be accepted on the basis that one of the authors will attend the conference and present the paper.

Abstract and full papers can be submitted through the respective coordinator to secretariat of conference, The important deadlines of the conference are as follows:

Abstract Submission	- 15th August, 2016
Full Paper Submission	- 31st September, 2016
